COMMUNICATIONS (INFRINGEMENT NOTICE REGIME) DECLARATION 2020

COMMUNICATIONS ACT 2015

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 162(7) of the Communications Act 2015, the Minister makes the following Declaration -

PART I — PRELIMINARY

1 Short Title

This Declaration may be cited as the Communications (Infringement Notice Regime) Declaration 2020.

2 Commencement

This Declaration shall come into force on the date it is published in the Gazette.

3 Interpretation

- (1) Subject to subsection (2), unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in this Declaration have the same meaning as in the Communications Act 2015.
- (2) In this Declaration, unless the context otherwise requires:

"Act" refers to the Communication Act 2015; and

"infringement notice provision" has the same meaning in the Act.

PART II — INFRINGEMENT NOTICE REGIME

4 Infringement Notice Provisions

The following provisions of the Act shall be specified as infringement notice provisions -

- (a) Section 24;
- (b) Section 30;
- (c) Section 35;
- (d) Section 36;
- (e) Section 43;
- (f) Section 105;
- (g) Section 156;
- (h) Section 159; and
- (i) Section 169.

5 Penalties

The amount of any penalty that may be payable under an infringement notice in respect of an infringement notice provision, shall not exceed the maximum fine that a court could impose for the offences, as set out in the Schedule.
