Henceforth Her Majesty, The Queen Mother shall be laid to rest on the morning of Wednesday 1st March, 2017 with the Worship Service at the Royal Tombs, Mala'e Kula. The traditional Royal 'Tapu' ceremony will be observed with mourning for a period of ten days.
